The brand new DEFIANT model, which has generated tremendous interest since it was first announced it was coming to North America, has the hit the US Market running and continues to grow in demand.

A little late to the party is the new Base Orange design, arriving in the US market this July. Along with the traditional solid colors, a few graphics made the first shipment-among them the Base White. The simple, yet striking asymetrical stripes of the Base continues to be among the most talked about new designs for 2013, and the Orange version offers a splash of color that compliments almost any color out there.

The attributes of the new DEFIANT model have been well received by dealers and consumers alike, all of whom report that while the style attracted the most attention, it was the appointment of details and features that deliver new benefits. The DEFIANT certainly defies the assumption that this new model is just a stylized facelit on the RX-Q model, upon which it is based. The DEFIANT is truly a new helmet in its own right, fitting much like the RX Q, but offering improvements like enhanced ventilation and improved aerodynamics for better downforce and less lift with reduced wind noise.
